Ambassadors

To help the organisation of the event we plan to appoint national ambassadors or representatives. Their task will be to encourage MM sailors to compete in this great event and to make the selection of their nations team.

Entries

The maximum number of boats shall be 51. No country shall sail with more than 10 competitors. The initial closing date for Stage 1 entries shall be July 1st, 2010. Entries or requests for wildcards can be sent to Oosterheert.steven@gmail.com or being published on the forum of <http://micromagic.info>

The allocation of Stage 1 places shall take place within 14 days of the initial closing date.

The national ambassadors shall send their entries entering in Stage 2.

The MMI reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor.

- Stage 2 (from 1 to 15 July)

Then, if there are still places available, the countries still requiring places shall be listed in order of their team result from the last EC, followed by reverse numerical order of their national fleet size. Places shall be allocated one per country going down the list repeatedly until each country reaches the maximum allocation, or the entry limit is reached. The MMI class management may give out a maximum of 8 wildcards to sailors from countries not yet listed above or for another reason they think appropriate.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), Appendix E of the RRS, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and the Micro Magic International Class Rules.

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

The English language versions of these document shall prevail.

Heat Management System

The Championship will be sailed under the HMS system. Sailed in 3 heats with 6 up and 6 down promotion and relegation between heats.

Frequency and Sail Number

The race organisation shall assign each participant a unique sail number (usually it's normal sail number) and a unique frequency before the start of the Championships. All participants will be obliged to sail with these unless requested to do so by the organising committee. When two or more participants have the same sail number or frequency, the participant with its name higher in the alphabetical order shall keep its sail number or frequency, the other boat will be required to prefix its sail number with a 1, 2, etc until any conflict is resolved. 35 MHz is not allowed.

MMI

On Saturday evening there will be a MMI meeting organised by the MMI class management. One point on the agenda will be the next venue of the EC.

Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is 65 Euros and shall be paid in cash at inscription. Included are the Friday and Saturday dinner and Saturday and Sunday lunch. Family members can join the meals after paying 35 euros.

Class rules

The boats competing in this event have to comply with the current MMI class rule as published on http://micromagic.info/MMI_rule.pdf
